2.0 MAIN BUSINESS: NATIONAL COMPETITIVE TENDERS

(i) S/No. 1: Procurement of 4 x 4 SUV Vehicle for the Regional Centre for Energy and Environmental Sustainability (RCEES), UENR

One (1) firm, namely: Klataa Engineering Solutions Limited submitted tender.

The Submissions were as follows;

(i) Klataa Engineering Solutions Limited - GH¢ 1,740,000.00

The firm was however disqualified because they submitted an Official Receipt instead of Clearance Certificate from SSNIT as requested.

Recommendations:

There was no Recommendation for Award of Contract.

The underlisted firms were not substantially responsive based on the following reasons:

- a. **Contra-Focus Limited** was not responsive because the List of references provided by the firm were not related to Office Furniture.
- b. Yekna Investment Limited was not responsive because of the following reasons;
 - The firm did not provide information on payment terms as requested.
 - The firm did not provide Audited Financial Accounts for 2020 and 2021 as requested

Recommendations:

On the basis of the evaluation which was carried out in accordance with the Tender Documents, the Panel recommended the acceptance of Mat-Bans Company Limited at a total Tender Price of GH¢1,390,250.00

(iii) Procurement of Furniture for the Regional Centre for Energy and Environmental Sustainability (RCEES), UENR: Lot 2B: Auditorium Furniture,

Two (2) firms, namely: Mat-Bans Company Limited; and Contra-Focus Limited submitted tenders.

The Submissions were as follows:

- (i) Mat-Bans Company Limited- GH¢236,850.00
- (ii) Contra-Focus Limited GH¢428,480.00

Contra-Focus Limited was not substantially responsive because List of references provided by the firm were not related to Auditorium Furniture.

Recommendations:

On the basis of the evaluation which was carried out in accordance with the Tender Documents, the Panel recommended acceptance of Mat-Bans Company Limited at a total Tender Price of GH¢236,850.00.

(iv) Procurement of Furniture for the Regional Centre for Energy and Environmental Sustainability (RCEES), UENR: Lot 2C: Lecture Hall Furniture.

Four (4) firms, namely: White Pleasure Company Limited; Mat-Bans Company Limited; Contra-Focus Limited; and Yekna Investment Limited submitted tenders

IERCE battles have been reported as Ukraine tries to retake the Russian-occupied southern Kherson region - but military experts have told the BBC it "won't happen quickly".

"Heavy fighting is continuing, our soldiers are working around the clock," said Vitaliy Kim, who heads the neighbouring Mykolaiv region.

Ukraine earlier said it had broken through

Russia's first line of defence. But Russia said Ukrainian troops had been defeated during a failed attack.

The defence ministry in Moscow also said there had been heavy casualties among the krainian forces, but the claims by both Ukraine and Russia have not been independently verified.

Kherson became the first major Ukrainian city to fall into Russian hands in the opening days of Miscon's area or to the gashim 24

It said three key bridges across the Dnipro River had been hit again to make sure they were impassable. In recent weeks, Ukraine has also been using US-supplied Himars precision rocket systems to target makeshift Russian pontoon bridges, as well as command posts and ammunition depots.

This is widely seen as part of a targeted effort to cut off Russian troops on the right (western) bank of the river, making it virtually impossible to send troops and weapons resupplies.

However, officials in Kyiv have been cautioning against any expectations of a quick win, describing the offensive as a slow grinding down of the enemy.

Several military experts interviewed by the BBC seem to agree with this.

"The long-term trend is the gradual weak ening of the Russian military capability and the gradual strengthening of the Ukrainian capability with Western help," said Sir Alex Younger, a former head of Bor on 1880 Secret Intelligence Service.

He said the Kherson counter-offensive was "all about the urge of Ukraine to demonstrate they can get on the front foot and in turn underpin the resolve of Ukraine and its backers into what is going to be a difficult winter". -BBC

3.0 METHOD OF EVALUATION

1. REPORTING ENTITY

White Pleasure Company Limited is a company incorporated in Ghana under the Companies Act 1963, (Act 172) on the 24th November 2008. If in the future such estimates and assumptions which are based on management's best judgement at the date of the financical statement deviate from the actual circumstances, the original estimates and assumptions will be modified as appropriate in the year in which the circumstances change. Where necessary, the comparatives have been reclassified or extended from the previously reported results to take into account presentational changes.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACOUNTING POLICIES

The significant accounting policies adopted by the company in the preparation of these financial statemens are as follows:

A. PROPERTY PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at historical cost less depreciation. Depreciation has been provided on straight-line basis at rates calculated to reduce the assets to nil at the end of their expected useful lives. The principlal rates used for this purpose are:

B. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS

The financial statements are presented in Ghana Cedis which are the company's functional and presentation currency. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into Cedis at the rates prevailing at the date of the transaction. Residual balances denominated in Foreign Currencies are translated into Cedis using the exchange rates prevailing at the Balance sheet date. Gains or losses resulting from currency transactions are dealt with through the income statement.

C. TRADE RECEIVABLES

Trade receivables are carried at original invoice amount. An estimate is made for doubtful debts considered doubtful. Receivables are stated at their face value based on a review of all outstanding amounts at the year-end. Bad debts are written off during the year in which they are identified.

D. REVENUE RECOGNITION

Revenue is measured at fair value of the consideration received or receivable net of sales tax trade discounts and customers' returns. Revenue is recognized to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the company and the revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue is not recognized until the significant risk and reward of ownership of the goods and services have passed to the buyer and the amount of revenue can be measured reliably. Interest income is recognizes as it accrues.

E. INVENTORY

Inventory is stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Costs include all direct expenses incurred in bringing the goods to their current state under normal operating condition.

F. CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENT

For the purposes of the statement of cash flow, cash and cash equivalent comprise cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks, and investments in money market instruments, net bank overdrafts.

G. TAX

White Pleasure Company Limited registered under the Companies Act 2019 (Act 992), as a profit making organization and therefore eligible to pay tax at the current corporate tax rate of twenty-five percent.

WHITE PLEASURE COMPANY LIMITED NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2021

1. REPORTING ENTITY

White Pleasure Company Limited is a company incorporated in Ghana under the Companies Act 1963, (Act 172) on the 24st November 2008. The object of the company was amended through a board resolution on 7th July, 2009. The company is authorized by its amended regulations to engage in the business of supply of furniture and general merchant.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION

A. Statement of compliance

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards.

B. Basis of measurement

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention

C. Functional and presentation currency

The financial statements are prepared in Ghana Cedis which is the company's functional and presentation currency

D. Use of estimates and judgements

The preparation of the financial statements requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of revenues, expenses, assets and liabilities, and the disclosure of contingent liabilities at the date of the financial statements. If in the future such estimates and assumptions which are based on management's best judgement at the date of the financical statement deviate from the actual circumstances, the original estimates and assumptions will be modified as appropriate in the year in which the circumstances change. Where necessary, the comparatives have been reclassified or extended from the previously reported results to take into account presentational changes.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACOUNTING POLICIES

The significant accounting policies adopted by the company in the preparation of these financial statemens are as follows:

A. PROPERTY PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at historical cost less depreciation. Depreciation has been provided on straight-line basis at rates calculated to reduce the assets to nil at the end of their expected useful lives. The principlal rates used for this purpose are:

20%

FURNITURE AND FITTINGS

20%

MOTOR VEHICLE

25%

PLANT AND MACHINERY

20%

B. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS

The financial statements are presented in Ghana Cedis which are the company's functional and presentation currency. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into Cedis at the rates prevailing at the date of the transaction. Residual balances denominated in Foreign Currencies are translated into Cedis using the exchange rates prevailing at the Balance sheet date. Gains or losses resulting from currency transactions are dealt with through the income statement.

C. TRADE RECEIVABLES

Trade receivables are carried at original invoice amount. An estimate is made for doubtful debts considered doubtful. Receivables are stated at their face value based on a review of all outstanding amounts at the year-end. Bad debts are written off during the year in which they are identified.

D. REVENUE RECOGNITION

Revenue is measured at fair value of the consideration received or receivable net of sales tax trade discounts and customers' returns. Revenue's recognized to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the company and the revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue is not recognized until the significant risk and reward of ownership of the goods and services have passed to the buyer and the amount of revenue can be measured reliably. Interest income is recognizes as it accrues.

E. INVENTORY

Inventory is stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Costs include all direct expenses incurred in bringing the goods to their current state under normal operating condition.

F. CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENT

For the purposes of the statement of cash flow, cash and cash equivalent comprise cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks, and investments in money market instruments, net bank overdrafts.

G. TAX

White Pleasure Company Limited registered under the Companies Act 2019 (Act 992), as a profit making organization and therefore eligible to pay tax at the current corporate tax rate of twenty-five percent.
